BRIEF HISTORY OF ARONAI COLLEGE

The ARONAI COLLEGE, Kokrajhar was established on 13th January, 2013 through a resolution No. 3 adopted in a Public Meeting held at Bedlangmari, Kokrajhar under the Presidentship of Sjt. Hagrama Mohilary, Hon'ble Chief of Bodoland Territorial Council. The huge gathering of intellectuals felt the necessity for opening of a Degree College in the name and style of "ARONAI COLLEGE, আর'নাই ফরাইসালিমা". The College is



located at Dimalgaon, Kokrajhar, 1 km away from Bodoland Territorial Council Secretariat.

The College came into existence with the active co-operation and selfless dedication of the people of Kokrajhar. The College started in the beginning with altogether 97 students, the sum total of students of both Arts and Science stream. The College started temporarily in Commerce College, Kokrajhar (Arts Stream) and Science College, Kokrajhar (Science Stream) during the first year of the opening of the college. On 2014, the college was shifted to Dimalgaon, Kokrajhar which is now the permanent College building of Aronai College. Thanks to the relenting and untiring efforts of the band of dedicated workers like Sjt. Hagrama Mohilary (Hon'ble Chief of BTC), Smti. Pramila Rani Brahma (Hon'ble Ex-Minister, Govt. of Assam), Mr. Hemandra Nath Brahma (Ex-Principal of Aronai College) and all the governing body members of Aronai College, Kokrajhar.

The College offers four-year undergraduate (FYUGP) programmes under NEP 2020 and higher secondary courses for both arts and science stream. The College is affiliated to Bodoland University and recognized by UGC under Section 2 (f) of the UGC Act, 1956 vide no. *F. No. 8-123/2022 (CPP-I/C)* dated 30 Aug 2023.

OUR VISION: "Excellence in Education". Aronai College, Kokrajhar is to become one of the India's leading centre of excellence imparting quality education of the highest standard.

MOTTO: "Service to Humanity is Service to God". Aronai College, Kokrajhar serves as the centre for producing best quality human resource.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

The college adopts following admission procedures:

1. Candidates must apply online by registering and logging on the Assam State Higher Education Admission Portal-2026 <https://assamadmission.samarth.ac.in> for admission into various FYUGP programmes and on the Assam State School Education Board, Division-II (ASSEB, Div-II), Darpan Online Admission Portal – 2026 <https://darpan.ahseconline.in> for admission into Higher Secondary of Aronai College, Kokrajhar. The Application has to be submitted online within the prescribed date.
2. Eligible Candidates are enlisted and are duly notified through SAMARTH e-Gov web portal for FYUGP programmes and through DARPAN online portal for Higher Secondary. The seat strength for different degree programmes are indicated at *Annexure A*.
3. Selection and admission of candidates is strictly on the basis of merit to be judged as per approved regulation. Principal's decision regarding is final. Any pressure of interference from any quarters for admission will automatically disqualify the claims of admission seekers.
4. Applicants shall have to submit the following documents, along with the application form and shall have to produce/submit the documents in original at the time of reporting during admission.
 - a) Passport photograph (03 Copies)
 - b) Admit, Marksheet & Pass Certificate issued by the Board/University last attended
 - c) Migration Certificate issued by the Board/University last attended (if applicable)
 - d) Gap Certificate from the competent authority (if applicable)
 - e) Caste Certificate (if applicable)
 - f) Aadhaar,
5. The selected candidate has to take admission on payment of prescribed fees *online* through *PayU* by visiting the college website www.aronaicollege.ac.in. The fees payable for different degree programmes under various heads are indicated at *Annexure B*. The fees and charges mentioned under this clause are subject to revision as and when necessary.

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SEAT RESERVATIONS

The College makes provision for reservation of seats for eligible candidates belonging to the following categories.

1. Scheduled Caste (SC): 7%	6. Economically Weaker Section (EWS): 10% reservation from unreserved category in each subject
2. Scheduled Tribes (ST) Plains: 10%	7. Sons and Daughters of permanent Aronai College Employees: 1 seat in each dept. with intake capacity 20 or less and 2 seats when the intake is 40 or less
3. Scheduled Tribes (ST) Hills: 5%	8. Aronai College Ex-Employees: 2 Seats
4. OBC & MOBC: 15%	9. Extra-curricular: 1 seat in each department
5. Differently Abled (PwD): 3%	10. NCC & NSS: 2 seats

Candidates are to note that self-certified copies of certificates mentioned against each of the categories must be submitted along with the application form at the time of reporting.

a) **Scheduled Caste (SC)** specified in relation to the State of Assam under Article 341 of the Constitution of India (Certificate from the competent authority countersigned by DC/ADC)

b) **Scheduled Tribes (ST) Plains and Hills** specified in relation to the State of Assam under Article 342 of the Constitution of India (Certificate from the competent authority countersigned by DC/ADC)

c) **Other Backward Classes/More Other Backward Classes (OBC/MOBC)** specified in relation to the State of Assam. Under this category, some seats shall be reserved for Tea Garden Labourer (TGL), Moran, Motak, Koch Rajbongshi, Tai Ahom and Chutia community (Certificate from the competent authority countersigned by DC/ADC).

d) **Economically Weaker Sections (EWS)** specified in accordance with the provisions of the Constitution (103rd Amendment) Act, 2019, Govt. of India *vide* OM dated 17th Jan, 2019 (dhe/mhrd). The income-asset of the families is to be certified by an officer not below the rank of Circle Officer

e) To be eligible for consideration under **Differently Abled (PwD)**, candidate must produce necessary PwD certificate issued by competent authority.

f) Candidates who are children of **permanent Aronai College employees, retired/deceased College employees** (Certificate from the Principal, Aronai College).
